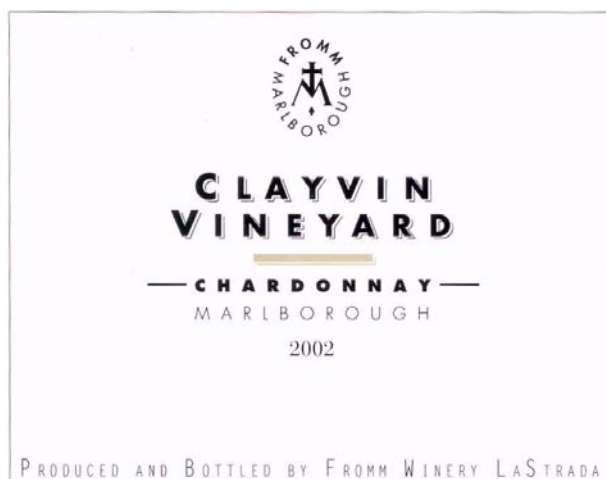




Fromm . Chardonnay 2002 . Clayvin Vineyard

Comment Rather restrained nose, revealing just hints of the wine's underlying dimensions. On the palate there is a richness but also tightness, quite a big wine with solid structure and a degree of minerality associated with the low cropping Mendoza clone in this vineyard. This full bodied Chardonnay is bone-dry with moderate acidity and low pH after full malo-lactic fermentation, providing a more austere texture and balance, less typical for New World wines. Matured for over two years in French oak barrels (no new wood used). The wine was bottled without filtration.

Short description Full-bodied Chardonnay, dry and minerally with moderate acidity. Understated with slightly austere texture; firm and flavourful finish. (August 2004)
