Comment

Complex, dry Chardonnay, combining great flavour density with distinct terroir related minerality, typical of this hillside site.

It's a classic Clayvin Chardonnay, uncompromisingly dry and positively austere in its youth before its transition into early maturity. At present the wine is going through this metamorphosis, gaining in weight, complexity and textural refinement while retaining its precise structure and should fully blossom from 2011 onwards. Fermented and matured in 2 . 4 year old barrels, the oak influence is barely noticeable allowing the wine to be truly expressive of its origin and the vintage.

Short description

Classic Clayvin Chardonnay, dry, complex and concentrated, precise firm structure, finishing with refined texture. (May 2010)

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
