**Comment**

Dense, saturated inky/purple colour. On the nose real depth, concentrated black fruit, masculine and distinctly tarry. The palate combines flavour intensity and youthfulness with wonderful varietal expression. Despite its inherent, firm tannin structure, this young Malbec is already remarkably drinkable, especially with food, but of course it will greatly benefit from a few years cellaring.

**Short description**

Saturated inky/purple colour, real depth, masculine, lots of concentrated black fruit with firm tannin structure, a serious food wine. (January 2003)
