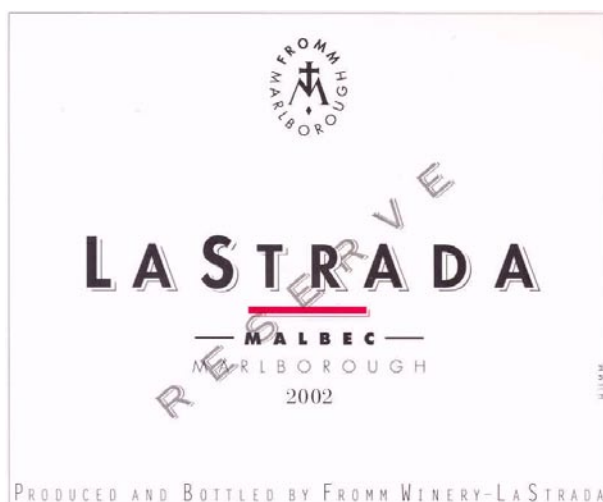

Comment

Saturated, dark-red colour, deep and vibrant. The nose is very Malbec, exhibiting a penetrating intensity of concentrated dark berry flavours. The palate is generous, loaded with aromatic, ripe fruit and complemented by excellent tannin support. However, the wine is neither heavy or jammy, just pure cool-climate expression of Malbec. This unusual (and hard to grow) variety is most commonly planted in Argentina and the French district of Cahors, yet for us its texture and tannin structure are more reminiscent of wines from Tuscany/Italy.

Short description

Dense, dark-red colour. Powerful and concentrated cool-climate expression of Malbec; spicy, aromatic, good focus and a vibrant finish.
