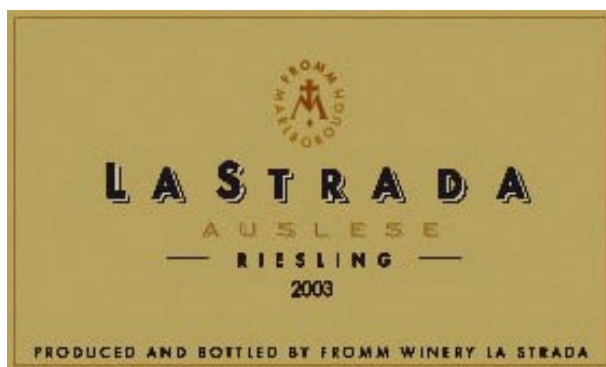




La Strada . Riesling Auslese 2003

Comment 2003 was a very good year for Riesling. The variety escaped the spring frosts untouched and the overall cool weather conditions retained good acidity and clean, clear varietal definition.

The wine is still quite closed on the nose, showing nuances of peach and exotic fruit and subtle complexities. On the palate the first impression is obvious lush sweetness offset by a tight, low pH structure and a racy mouth-drying finish. With only 7% alcohol we expect this wine to develop into a deliciously light yet concentrated Auslese.

Short description Discreet flavours of peach and exotic fruit, tight structured yet lush and sweet and balanced with racy acidity. Deliciously light at only 7% alcohol.
